My trip to Europe cost me an arm and a leg.

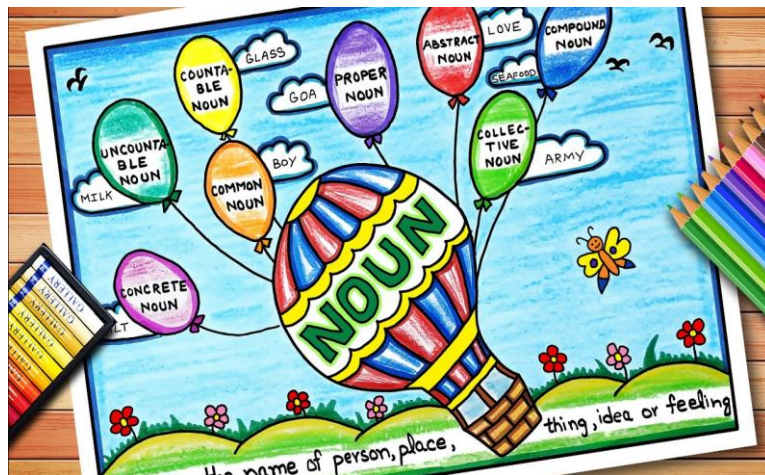

I. Currency Craft – Make Your Own Shop

Concepts Covered:

Money, addition, subtraction, total cost

Materials Needed:

- Paper strips for pretend currency
- Sketch pens/crayons
- 5–6 toys or small household items
- Small notebook

Activity Steps:

1. Make your own currency notes: Rs. 10, 20, 50, 100, 500 using colored paper or card.
2. Set up a small shop with 5–6 items and give them price tags.
3. Play with family members — buy and sell using your paper notes.
4. Keep a notebook and write the total bill for each purchase.
5. Calculate how much money was given and the balance to return.

Expected Outcome:

Understanding of money handling, bills and transaction calculations.

II. Number Rangoli

Concepts Covered:

Odd-even numbers, number patterns, multiplication tables

Materials Needed:

- Plain sheet
- Color pencils/crayons
- Pencil and eraser

Activity Steps:

1. Draw a simple rangoli pattern with circles, lines and curves.
2. In one design, fill numbers from 1 to 20, using only odd numbers.
3. In another design, use numbers from any multiplication table (like 2, 5 or 3).
4. Color your rangoli brightly.

Expected Outcome:

Recognition of number patterns, odd-even numbers and number sequences in creative settings.
